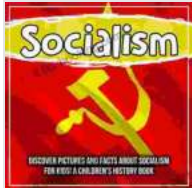

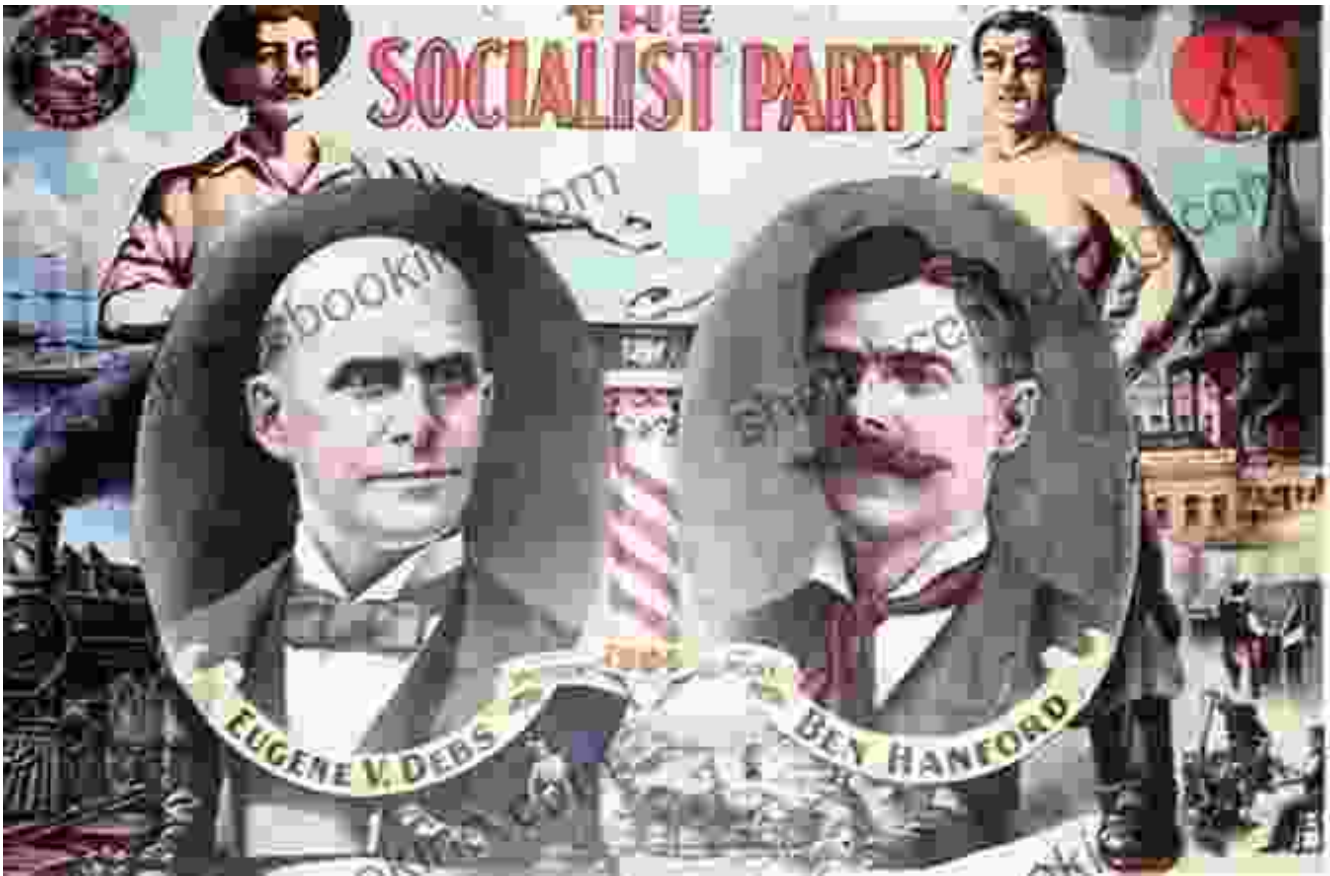

- COMMUNISM suggests that everyone in society contributes and works according to their ability, and gets back everything according to their needs.

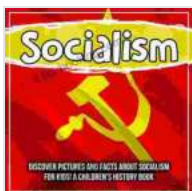

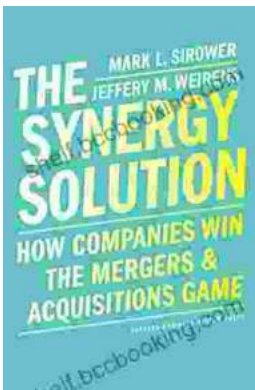

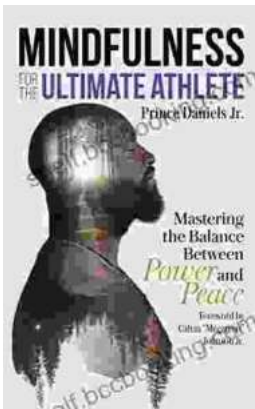
